USED OIL RECYCLING

Each year in Virginia, do-it-yourself oil changers improperly dispose of over four million gallons of used motor oil by placing it in the trash, pouring it on the ground or pouring it down a storm drain. The consequences for our environment are polluted ground and surface waters. It takes only one quart of oil to contaminate thousands of gallons of water. We can prevent this by recycling used oil.

At most Southeastern Public Service Authority (SPSA) facilities, collection tanks are provided to accept used motor oil from area residents, free of charge. SPSA facilities also accept old car batteries. For used oil disposal/recycling locations, other than SPSA facilities, please call your local automotive parts & service center or visit www.deq.state.va.us/recycle/usedoil.html. Most service stations and automotive centers accept used oil for recycling.

Bring your used oil and car batteries to a collection site near you and help prevent pollution and the loss of an invaluable energy source.
