As a leader in the solid waste management industry, the Southeastern Public Service Authority has an inherent responsibility to set an example in environmental stewardship. SPSA is committed to the protection of the environment. In recognition of this responsibility, SPSA hereby establishes the following environmental policy.

All SPSA activities will be conducted in an environmentally sound and sensitive manner. All SPSA facilities will function as "good neighbors" through competent operation, maintenance, continuous environmental monitoring and public dissemination of information.

These are SPSA's commitments:

Environmental Management System

SPSA will maintain an Environmental Management System (EMS) to organize and control its environmental activities. The EMS will identify environmental aspects of SPSA's operations. The EMS will establish targets and objectives for environmental improvement and set timeframes to accomplish those objectives. It will also establish methods to review targets and objectives and clearly designate the responsibilities of SPSA personnel in utilization of the EMS. The EMS will be fully compliant with the ISO-14001 international environmental standard.

Recycling

SPSA will promote and implement recycling throughout our organization to the fullest extent practical.

Pollution Prevention

SPSA is committed to minimizing and mitigating, to the best of our ability and resources, all adverse environmental impacts associated with our activities. SPSA will actively seek and employ operational strategies that promote pollution prevention and foster environmental protection. SPSA will conduct annual environmental trainings for all employees in areas such as Stormwater, Spill Response, and Unauthorized Waste. Annual trainings are one method SPSA utilizes to prevent environmental damage by ensuring employees are knowledgeable of proper procedures to prevent pollution.

Regulatory Compliance

SPSA will maintain compliance with federal, state and local environmental laws and regulations. SPSA will design, construct and operate state-of-the-art solid waste management facilities that meet or exceed all regulatory requirements for environmental soundness.

Community Education

SPSA believes citizens and communities can and will participate in the protection of the environment, if given knowledge and mean to do so. Through the dissemination of information, individuals can learn about environmental issues, problems and solutions. SPSA will actively work to educate the public on environmental protection issues associated with solid waste disposal, and serve as an information resource throughout this learning process.


Continual Improvement
